Summary of what this spreadsheet data shows:

2014 TABLE #5 REPORTED CRIMES BY STATE / TABLE # 69 REPORTED ARRESTS FOR ALL CRIMES

REPORTED CRIMES 2014: **9,475,816** (DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA AND PUERTO RICO REPORTED CRIMES BUT ONLY DC HAD INFORMATION RELATING TO SOME ARRESTS SO CRIMES IN PUERTO RICO WERE NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOTAL)

• REPORTED CRIMES HAVE A VICTIM WHO EITHER CONTACTED THE POLICE AND FILLED OUT A CRIMINAL REPORT, OR A CRIMINAL REPORT WAS INITIATED/ FILED ON BEHALF OF A VICTIM WHO WAS UNABLE TO REPORT THE CRIME FOR WHICH THEY WERE THE VICTIM: INCLUDES MURDER AND NON NEGLIGENT MANSLAUGHTER, FORCIBLE RAPE, AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, ROBBERY... PROPERTY CRIMES INCLUDE BURGLARY, LARCENY- THEFT, MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT AND ARSON ETC.

(NON REPORTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY ARREST IS ANY ARREST WHERE THE ARRESTING LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENT INITIATED THE ARREST BASED ON HIS OR HER OBSERVATION- FOR WHICH THERE IS NO VICTIM REPORTING A CRIME- SEE THE TYPES OF ARRESTS MADE FOR NON REPORTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY IN THE LIST BELOW)

PERCENTAGE OF ARRESTS FOR NON REPORTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY: **81.59%**

UPON FIRST GLANCE, IT APPEARS THAT THERE WERE MORE ARRESTS MADE THAN THERE WERE CRIMINAL REPORTS FILED... UNTIL YOU REALIZE THAT THE MAJORITY OF ARRESTS WERE NOT FOR REPORTED CRIMES, AND IN FACT, ARRESTS FOR REPORTED CRIMES WERE ONLY **18.41%** OF ALL ARRESTS MEANING THAT OF THE **9,475,816** REPORTED CRIMES, **7,697,907** WERE NOT SOLVED AND THE PERPETRATORS ARE STILL AT LARGE.

BUT NOT TO WORRY! THE **626,796** STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS*₂ WHO WERE OUT THERE FIGHTING CRIME WERE VERY SUCCESSFUL IN APPREHENDING ALL THOSE "CRIMINALS" WHO WERE UNFORTUNATE ENOUGH TO ENCOUNTER A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENT WHO WAS SIMPLY TOO INCOMPETENT TO FIND A CRIMINAL WHO HAD A VICTIM. IN FACT, THE AVERAGE NUMBER OF ARRESTS MADE PER COP PER YEAR IN 2014 WAS...

A STAGGERING 15.41... GOOD THING THEY REALLY ARE INCOMPETENT, OR THEY WOULD HAVE HAULED IN EVEN MORE ADULTS FOR VIOLATING THE SENSIBILITIES OF MORAL AND SOCIAL BUSYBODIES... HERE'S THE CALCULATION FOR FINDING THE AVERAGE NUMBER OF ARRESTS MADE PER COP PER YEAR:

9,655,899 ÷ BY 626,796 = 15.41 ARRESTS PER YEAR... NOT PER MONTH... PER YEAR...

CONSIDERING THAT IT TAKES, ON AVERAGE, 40 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS TO RESCUE ONE CHILD DURING THE ANNUAL "OPERATION CROSS COUNTRY" STING, ONE WONDERS HOW ON EARTH IT WOULD BE POSSIBLE TO "END THE DEMAND" (FOR PROSTITUTES OF ALL AGES) WHEN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS WE HAVE NOW CAN'T ARREST MORE THAN 18% OF ALL REPORTED CRIMES... AND WOULD THE PROSTITUTION ABOLITIONISTS REALLY CLAIM THAT IT IS MORE

IMPORTANT TO SQUANDER THE SCARCE AND VALUABLE RESOURCES ARRESTING ADULT MEN AND WOMEN FOR ENGAGING IN COMMERCIAL SEX WHERE NEITHER PARTICIPANT HAS CALLED THE POLICE AND ASKED FOR HELP?

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The bar above between the arrows is directly from the FBI's XLS spreadsheet - we colorized the heading row of most of the columns for so called 'vice criminal activities' to highlight those for which there was no 'reporting victim' other than the law enforcement officer making the arrest. "Forcible rape" is also noted by color solely to highlight that crime for which so few arrests were made compared to the number of reported incidents. The categories of "violent crime" and "property crime" include: murder and non negligent manslaughter, forcible rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny- theft, motor vehicle theft and arson. Crimes designated as "other assaults, forgery and counterfeiting, fraud, embezzlement, stolen property: buying/ receiving/ possessing and vandalism" most likely had a reporting victim, but the FBI stats do not include them in the 'reported crimes' table # 5 stats. So for the purposes of this document, we did not include them in the 'reported crimes' category either, because we do not know how the local law enforcement agencies reported them to the FBI.

NOTE: THERE IS NO SEPARATE CATEGORY WITHIN THESE ANNUAL REPORTS AND STATISTICS FROM THE FBI FOR 'HUMAN TRAFFICKING,' 'SEX TRAFFICKING' OR FOR 'PANDERING/ PIMPING' OR FOR NON COMMERCIAL CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION/ SO THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO WAY FOR ANYONE TO MAKE ANY SORT OF 'EDUCATED GUESSTIMATE' OF HOW MANY ARRESTS ARE MADE EACH YEAR FOR THOSE 'CRIMES.' WHY THERE ISN'T A 'CRIMINAL CATEGORY' FOR THOSE ACTIVITIES IS ANYONE'S GUESS. MAYBE SOME BRAVE AND DARING SOUL COULD ASK THEM.....?????????
