

## Former police officer views child porn again

David Krego, a former Water-ville Township police officer, violated the terms of his community control.

A former Waterville Township police officer who went to prison in 2012 for viewing child pornography will spend 15 more days in jail.

David Krego, 45, of 7321 Seaman Rd., Oregon, admitted Tuesday that he violated the terms of his community control by again viewing child pornography.

Judge Myron Duhart of Lucas County Common Pleas Court ordered Krego to serve 15 days at the Corrections Center of Northwest Ohio beginning June 1 after he is scheduled to graduate from Owens Community College where he told the court he has been studying welding.

Judge Duhart continued the terms of Krego's community control that were imposed in November, 2012, after Krego was released from prison after serving seven months of a one-year sentence.

The judge told Krego he realized he had a troubled past and an addiction problem, but said he had to take control of his life, take responsibility, and move forward.

"You've got tools. If you don't use the tools you're going to cause me to put you back in prison," Judge Duhart said, adding, "If you come back, I'm not going to have this conversation again."

Krego tearfully apologized and asked the court for another chance.

In 2012, he pleaded no contest to one count of illegal use of a minor in nudity-oriented material, a fifth-degree felony. A patrol officer with the Waterville Township Police Department since 1996, he resigned as part of a plea agreement.
