Former Robstown Officer Learns Bond Conditions

CORPUS CHRISTI - The former Robstown cop accused of having sex with a teen girl returned to court today. Judge Jose Longoria says 27-year-old Ernest Martinez IV must stay away from schools, churches, playgrounds or any other places children

congregate if he can posthis \$200,000 bond. He'll also have a curfew from 8 p.m. to 6 a.-m.

Martinez turned himself into police Thursday afternoon on a charge of sexual assault of a 14-year-old girl. An arrest affidavit claims Martinez met the girl while working patrol at a Robstown school.

He currently lives in Portland and is not working after the Taft Police Department and Rockport Police Department turned down his application.

Martinez resigned from the Robstown Police Department last month as investigators were looking into issues regarding off-duty misconduct.
